



Investigative Projecting

Important Topics in Journalism - Staff Adventure

The Investigative Projecting assignment is an extended-type performance task. Teams of staff will research a topic and create **10 minute presentation** to teach the class.

It is assessed using a rubric, where **comprehension and application of unit concepts is measured** through teamwork skills, quality of multimedia project, quality of presentation delivery, knowledge of content, and language conventions.

Staff teams will have one and a half blocks of work time to collaborate.

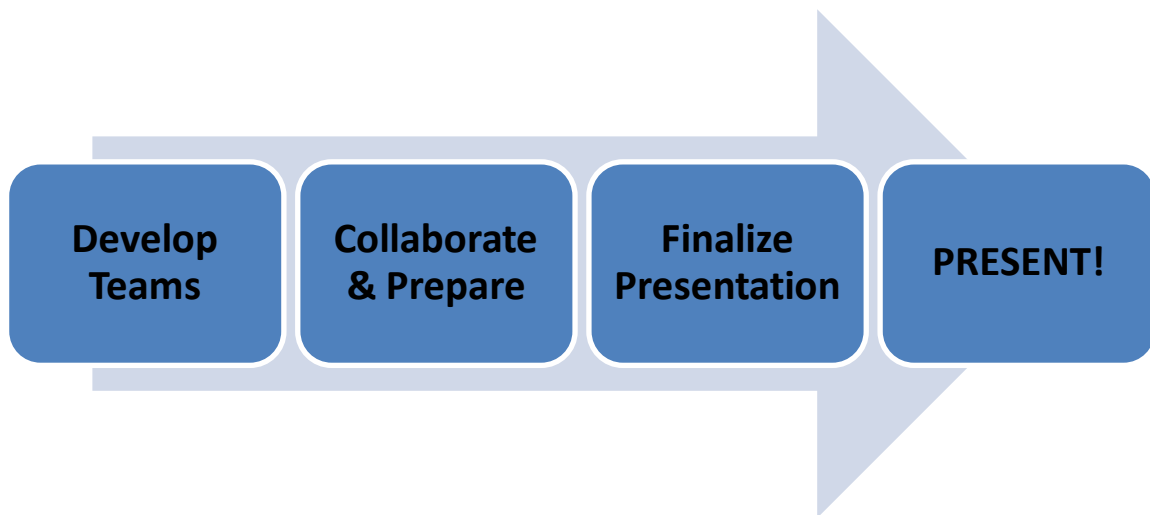

Requirements: Team project must...

1. meet rubric criteria for score of "Advanced" in each category
2. be the product of collaboration among team members
3. appear in multimedia form (prezi, PowerPoint, Google Slide, Weebly website)
4. include a minimum of 3 images and 1 link or embedded video
5. meet the length requirement of 10 minutes
6. reflect time, creativity, and a wealth of knowledge
